

- Population:
   16 Mio. Inhabitants (Sichuan: 82 Mio. Inhabitants)
- 2016 GDP:
   CNY 1.12 trillion RMB or ~155 billion
   EUR
- GDP per capita:
   CNY 63,977 RMB or ~10,397 EUR
- 15 consulates in Chengdu (US, Germany, France, Singapore, Australia, Switzerland) and more to come
- Increasing focus on high-tech
- Part of "Modern Silk Road" OBOR


## Chengdu Overview Growth Opportunities



- Growth rates in past > 5 years consistently above national average
- 278 Fortune 500 companies
- Pilot free trade zone and special investment zones
- Cross-border e-commerce trial city
- Electronic information manufacturing industry: 446bn. RMB / 50% growth
- Automotive Industry has grown to 8,3%, 150bn. RMB with 1 Mio vehicles
- Aviation & Aerospace has grown by 15% (50bn RMB) by 2015 -> 2017
- 53 Excellent schools & universities with international cooperation (e.g. SWUFE & Sichuan Univ.)

## Chengdu Overview Gateway to China and Europe





- 4<sup>th</sup> largest airport in China (>40 Mio. passengers in 2016)
- 72-hour visas
- 91 direct international flights
- Tourism GDP: 204bn. RMB / 20%
- Transportation / Logistics GDP / growth: 86bn.RMB / 11.4%
- Largest regional hub for cargo Railways
- Cargo Train Chengdu PL Germany
- Modern Metro/Subway: Passengers :


#### Southwest offers positive conditions for investment

- SW's growth remains well above China's national average


